



## Scholarship Information

### Purpose

Clear the Air Foundation has created a scholarship program for prospective automotive technicians entering the new car franchises. The focus is the student who is already enrolled as a tech student and may need assistance and those who haven't yet entered school.

### Process

- Initially, twenty scholarships of \$2,500 each will be awarded to students attending an automotive/diesel college.
- The scholarship is a one-time award.
- The Clear the Air Foundation scholarship will be used to fill the gap between the tuition and the amount that will be paid by the student.
- Scholarship application will be posted for 1 month before making a decision.
- Must complete application with accompanying bio.

### Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Have received a high school diploma or GED.
- Have received at least a 2.5 grade point average (un-weighted) at the time the application is submitted.
- Be a US citizen or permanent legal resident.
- Have an 80% attendance rating during the time in the program.

*Individuals who are related to a member of the scholarship selection committee or board member are not eligible to apply.*

### Selection

This program aims to support engaged students who have made a positive impact in the automotive community. Candidates will be evaluated on their personal statement, leadership, and involvement in extracurricular activities as well as academic achievement and any outstanding circumstances.

### Selection Committee (Suggested)

The selection committee is made up of 5 members.

- Clear the Air Foundation Director
- Colorado Automobile Dealers Association President
- One additional Colorado Automobile Dealers Association Board Member
- Automotive Industry Professional
